As we do most years, in 2024 we published 52 issues of the Valley Talking News, our weekly audio news magazine. We continuously work to improve both content and format. We've also systematized the uploading of those same files to our podcast, enabling anyone – subscriber or not – access to the newest Valley Talking News publications. KRUVradiosun operates 24/7 and attracts an increasing number of volunteers, some music lovers and others fans of old time radio. They are breathing new life into RRRB's radio station.

Our volunteers are amazing. They are busy people, yet despite other commitments, they are faithful to do the many activities it takes to keep RRRB's doors open. Many read, either from news articles selected for general interest or humor, or from books or articles. Others conduct interviews. Others use technology to record the

readers and edit. Some volunteers focus their efforts on the tasks associated with the cartridges containing the content.

In addition, in 2024 our volunteers were happy to narrate and record eight "single reader" books as requested by patrons of the Arizona Talking Book Library. Other volunteers narrated issues of the *Arizona History Journal*.

And last, but not least, we were delighted to have the opportunity to create three audio books for local authors.


